The Nintendo Switch has made several changes to its Mario U game compared to previous titles, starting with the character selection screen where players can choose between Toad and Nabbit or play as Mii. The new Joy-Con controller allows for seamless mode switching, eliminating the need for separate Wii U GamePad, Wii Remote, and Wii U Pro Controller options. Both Mario U and Luigi U have undergone updates in their endings and cutscenes, with Nabbit consistently appearing in the background. In the introduction, Blue Toad is absent, while Toadette takes his place. The button layout for menus and maps has been revamped, featuring 2D graphics with bolts and outlines. The Main Menu now includes "Delete" and "Copy" options, which were previously missing. Additionally, the player's HUD has seen improvements, including clearer icon outlines and enhanced star coin tracking. New Super Mario Bros. Nabbit now possesses voice clips similar to those of Toads. The game's athletic theme has undergone a change, with new instruments near the end.
