This is an energy bill from PSEG New Jersey for Charense Cleveland's household. The document outlines the previous balance, payments received, current balance, and amount due. It also details usage statistics, showing that this month was 1°F colder compared to last year. The customer has a total of \$67.09 due by October 6, 2024. PSEG offers various payment methods, which are listed on the reverse side of the document. Customers can register for MyAlerts and pay their bills electronically through the company's website or mobile app. The bill reflects changes in the supply and delivery portions of the customer's bill, effective June 1, 2024, resulting in an average monthly increase of \$5.57 or 4.1% for a typical residential customer.
